The Master of Information Technology Management (MITM) is for IT graduates and professionals who want to develop the skills needed to be part of an increasingly dynamic information technology industry. Throughout the duration of the degree you will:

Capstone Project

- Acquire the skills and knowledge to anticipate, manage and deliver technological advances in order to gain a competitive advantage in a commercial setting.
- Learn how to integrate IT with fundamental business • concepts and functions, enabling you to make the best business-technology decisions.

Industry Focussed

There is a rising demand across all business sectors for IT experts who can add value to organisational processes through the application of information and technological innovation. UOWD's MITM degree has been designed in collaboration with key industry stakeholders, meaning that graduates develop the leadership skills they need throughout the degree to progress to senior roles in information management and governance. Our compulsory professional practice and research project will allow you to investigate an industry issue, giving you a real-world experience and the opportunity to develop and apply the skills you have learnt throughout your master's degree.

Program Structure

There are two entry levels to the Master of Information Technology Management. If you have completed a three year bachelor's degree, or a four year bachelor degree without a research component, you will enter the MITM at the foundation level. This will involve taking two subjects prior to starting out on the degree, to be decided in consultation with the Faculty. If you have completed a four year degree that included a research component, you will enter directly onto the degree and complete 9 subjects. **Career Paths**

Master of Engineering Management

Master of Engineering Management (MEM) is for engineering graduates who are looking to develop their skills and competencies to manage large-scale engineering challenges. Throughout the duration of the degree you will:

- Acquire the skills to successfully integrate technical and project management skills while optimising the use of personnel, resources, equipment and information to deliver successful engineering projects.
- Learn how to develop and demonstrate creative, analytical and conceptual skills to analyse, diagnose and execute strategic judgements across all engineering functions.
- Learn how to manage teams effectively and to understand managers from other disciplines.
- Acquire the technical skills to support decisionmaking processes in complex business and industrial environments.



Industry Focussed

There is a rising demand across the MENA region and beyond for engineering professionals who can combine both technical and management expertise. UOWD's MEM degree has been designed in collaboration with key industry stakeholders, meaning that graduates develop the leadership skills they need. The compulsory dissertation subject will also allow you to solve a specific practical engineering problem, giving you a real-world experience and the opportunity to develop and apply the skills you have learnt throughout your master's degree.

Project Management Professional (PMP) Qualification

The Project Management Professional (PMP) is the most important industry-recognised certification for project management. By choosing to enrol for UOWD's MEM degree and taking the Engineering Project Management core subject, you will be satisfying one of the key application criteria for the qualification as you are able to use this subject as evidence of your 35 hours of project management education.

Program Structure

There are two entry levels to Master of Engineering Management (MEM). If you have completed a three year bachelor degree or a four year bachelor degree without a research component, you will enter the MEM degree at the foundation level. You will need to complete two additional subjects, to be decided in consultation with the Faculty, prior to starting the degree. If you have completed a four year degree which included a research component, you will enter the degree directly and complete 9 subjects.

Note: Applicants with a bachelor's degree in the relevant field of study, or its equivalent, with an overall:

* GPA between 2.5 and 2.99 (on a 4.0 scale) may be conditionally admitted to a master's degree, only if they meet the necessary english language requirement. Such students must take a maximum of 18cp of subjects studied for the master's degree during the period of conditional admission and must achieve an overall WAM of 55 in their first 3 subjects at the University. Students who fail to achieve this standard may have their enrolment discontinued.

** GPA between 2.0 and 2.49 (on a 4.0 scale) may be conditionally admitted to a master's degree, only if they meet the necessary english language requirement and they will be required to complete a maximum of 18cp remedial non-credit bearing subjects prior to enrolment in their chosen master's degree. Students must achieve a minimum WAM of 55 in these subjects in order to progress to the master's degree or may have their enrolment discontinued.

All instruction at UOWD is carried out in English and you will need to demonstrate an adequate level of English language proficiency in order to enrol. Please check uowdubai. ac.ae/join-uowd/admission-requirements/masters-degrees for complete admission requirements.

Program Fees

The total cost of a master's program is calculated on a per subject basis. Please check uowdubai.ac.ae/join-uowd/fees/ masters-degree for a breakdown of fees and further details.

Scholarships and Grants

UOWD provides a range of scholarships which offer financial support to new and existing students at the commencement of each trimester (unless otherwise stated). Whilst it does not cover living and other study-related expenses, it reduces the financial pressure ensuring you enjoy a less stressful student experience.

Scholarships

• Academic Merit Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to applicants based on academic merit and who comply with the necessary requirements. It offers the recipients with a scholarship ranging from 15% to 25% of their tuition fees for the duration of their studies*.

• Sports Scholarships - Adam Gilchrist Sports Award

This award, named after Australian cricketer and UOW Brand Ambassador, Mr Adam Gilchrist AM, is awarded to two recipients at either bachelor's or master's level, in the Autumn trimester (which begins in September). It offers the recipients a scholarship of 50% of their tuition fees for the duration of their studies*.

Tuition Grants

UOWD offers a number of grants that provide discounted rates on program fees ranging from 5% to 20% of annual tuition costs*. Available tuition grants are:

• Family Tuition Grants

Immediate family members enrolling simultaneously at UOWD are eligible for tuition fee grants*.

• Alumni Tuition Grants

New or returning students may qualify for one of the following Alumni Tuition Grants. **The Alumni Grant** will be awarded to students who have graduated from a UOWD bachelor or master degree and wish to enrol in a subsequent degree program at UOWD**.

The Family of Alumni Tuition

Grant is available on annual tuition fees for students who have at least one family member who has graduated from a bachelors or masters program from UOWD only. The Family of Alumni grant is available at the start of every trimester and students must apply for the grant when they submit their Application for Admission form.

- Proof of two-year work experience i.e letter for employer etc. (MBA candidates only)

• Certified copies of official academic transcripts showing all courses studied and grades obtained, syllabus details of the courses you successfully completed (including information on course content) and an explanation of the grading system.
